“I’LL Take It”

- When:** Every Tuesday starting at 2:00 pm; Every Wednesday night at 6:30 pm.
- Where:** Club Room
- Cost:** Round #1 - #8 \$1.00 per set (three cards) / per round
Round #9 - #10 \$2.00 [er set (three cards) / per round
- Payout:** All money collected for each round is awarded to the winner of each round except the \$3.00 that goes in the jackpot.
- Money Collectors:** Before each round, collects money and lets the players select set(s).
- Winners:** When a player covers two of the three card set, they call out “WAITING”. When a player covers all three cards of the set, they call out ”I’LL TAKE IT”. Then they take their set to the dealer to verify their winning set and collect the money for that round. If there is more than one winner during a round, the funds will be divided equally.
